

This weekend is WORD OF GOD SUNDAY in Australia. Pope Francis instituted this celebration to encourage Catholics to celebrate, study and share the Word of God.

We celebrate Word of God in sacrament and liturgy. In celebrating we start to experience the Word made Flesh, the presence of Christ in the community. We show reverence to Scripture, particularly the Book of the Gospel, as a way acknowledging Christ is present.

In solemn celebration of the Eucharist, we process the Book of the Gospels to the altar and to the ambo. We welcome the Gospel with a joyful Alleluia, we light candles and incense the pages. After the proclamation of the Gospel, the book is quietly put away, for the words are no longer on the page, they are to now in the hearts of the congregation to be lived out in the world. We celebrate the Word in sacrament and so that we can carry the living Word to others.

We read the scripture for understanding. Pope Francis quotes St Jerome to remind us that "ignorance of scripture is ignorance of Christ." Together as a Church we read the scripture "according to the Spirit." (Gal 5:16). Scripture is understood through the lived experience of the Church. From the experiences of the early Church to the insights of modern archaeology and sociology, the Church seeks to understand what is God asking of us. Tradition and Scripture draw from the same well of Revelation, the presence of God amongst us. We read and understand the scripture together as Church. Each member of the Church contributes to the understanding of scripture from their experience of living the faith.

We pray and meditate on the scripture to allow God to change our hearts. Each day religious and priests are obligated to pray the scripture through the Divine Office. All Christians are invited to let the Word of God touch their hearts. Each day the scriptures can touch our heart in a new way. Through practices such as *lectio divina*, repeated mediation on a phrase of scripture, or praying the Divine Office, we let the Word of scripture work on us.

*We proclaim Scripture in our words and actions.* As Christians we are called to respond to the invitation of scripture. We are called to hear and see Jesus' words and actions and make them our own through what we say and do.

The Bible is not a history book but a story of salvation. We are not meant to read the Bible to understand the past but to understand ourselves as part of that story. When we celebrate, study and share the Word of God it is no longer just words on the page – it becomes alive in our Church. God is here, present, speaking to us and guiding us towards the Kingdom.


Latte Ladies

### **Pregnancy Crisis Incorporated (PCI)**

PCI is a Catholic not-for-profit comprised of men and women who volunteer to serve women and girls with crisis pregnancies and their unborn babies and any other children they may have. This is done through the immediate and ongoing provision of relief to those in distress, whether it is due to financial hardship, homelessness, domestic violence, pressure to abort their babies by family or their workplace, or for any other reason. Relief includes accommodation, food, and clothing during pregnancy and until around six months after birth, friendship and the easing of isolation and loneliness through visitation, material baby goods from nappies to prams to cots and everything in between, spiritual and emotional support, and referrals for, and accompaniment to, social welfare appointments, medical care, and counsel-ling. Further, they assist both men and women with post-abortion trauma crises.

Unfortunately, PCI's public liability insurance premiums have increased significantly this year, approximately an additional \$21,000 p.a., due to claims made by other organisations around the world. PCI receives no government funding and relies totally on donations.

To ease this financial burden, the group is hosting a dance, in their private capacity, to raise funds for PCI.



#### Remembering your parish in your Will

#### "Your light must shine before all so that they may see goodness in your acts." (Matthew 5:16)

The recommended wording for a gift in your Will to your parish is:

"I give [insert amount/percentage/asset/item] to The Corporation of the Trustees of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Brisbane for the use and benefit of general charitable, religious and educational purposes of the Our Lady, Queen of Apostles situated at 70 Appleby Road, Stafford 4053. In the event that the parish has changed its name or been amalgamated with another parish or parishes, this gift shall be given to the parish which at the date of my death incorporates the major area of the Our Lady, Queen of Apostles - Stafford Parish as it exists at the time of making of this Will."
