Christmas chaos, before and after Mass is a relatively quiet time. Why not let you kids wonder and try to guess what will be added to the stable over the next week (and what has been added from last



week??) ADVENT is a time of waiting and expectation—this will help your kids.

Ur ADVENT preparation for CHRISTMAS: Celebrating the Forgiveness of our Sins: Why not celebrate our common Sinfulness and that God never ceases to forgive and show us mercy? On <u>Thursday 13th December, 7.00pm</u>, we will celebrate the Second Rite of Penance. How to do that?? All those who wish to celebrate are asked to consider their sins, (spend some time reflecting on "why do I do these things") and write them and your answer down on a piece of paper BEFORE coming to church that night (DO NOT include your name!!). The basic structure of the Second Rite is: Introduction, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of Penance and concluding rite. During the Liturgy of Penance, you will process forward, hand your **OPEN sheet** of paper to Father, receive Absolution and return to your place.

Saturdays starting at 4pm until no one is waiting. A special Celebration of Penance -Thurs 13th Dec at 7pm (No Thursday Morning mass that day). MASS TIMES 22/23 Dec to 1st Jan 4th Sunday of Advent (22nd /23rd Dec): Sat 5pm, Sun 7am & 9am only. (No Sunday 5.30pm Mass) Christmas Eve: 6pm (Mass with adapted Liturgy of Word for children) 9pm (our "Midnight" Mass) **NOTE**: There is NO morning Mass on the 24th. Christmas Day: 8am only (No 5.30pm Mass on Christmas Day) Thurs 27th, Fri 28th—Masses as per usual. Weekend 29/30th Dec: Sat 5pm, Sun 7am & 9am only. (No Sunday 5.30pm Mass) NEW YEAR'S EVE: Mon 31st Dec: 6pm Vigil for the Feast of the "Mary, Mother of God" and New Years Eve. **NOTE**: There is NO Monday morning Mass on the 31st.

Tues 1st Jan, Wed 2nd Jan: No Mass or other Liturgy. Thursday 3rd & Friday 4th - Mass as per usual. Sat/Sun 5th/6th January onwards: Mass and Liturgy times will return to normal.
