It means that the Immigration will cut you off from any financial support including housing. You will be left with no income, no home... but you will

be able to work and access Medicare. If you can find a job within one day you will be able to survive - depending on what you're paid. This is what's happening to many "single" men and women seeking asylum. It seems that the Government is **testing our strength as a community** and is leaving charities and churches to pick up these desperate people more and more (without providing the funds).
