"**Prayer**," he added, "teaches us to abandon idolatry and the self-sufficiency of our ego, and to acknowledge our need of the Lord and his mercy."

"Almsgiving," he continued, refers to when "we escape from the insanity of hoarding everything for ourselves in the illusory belief that we can secure a future that does not belong to us."

In this way, he stressed, we can "rediscover the joy of God's plan for creation and for each of us, which is to love him, our brothers and sisters, and the entire world, and to find in this love our true happiness."

#### Tips on how to use them best.

- Fill in the tear off portion if wanting a receipt for tax purposes.
- Place tear off portion inside envelope. Do not leave it attached to the outside of the envelope. It rips when opening the envelope to process your donation.
- To save you time, after filling in your details on your first envelope—just print your name clearly on subsequent envelopes when at Stafford.
- All credit card payments are processed at the end of the campaign. If you would like to make a donation now, there are instructions for phone and internet on the back of the larger envelope.
- Don't encourage children or others to put empty envelopes on the plate. I still need to sort them, checking for money or credit card payments.
- If you miss a week, put your donations into one envelope only - it saves time for you and me.
- Finalise all donations by 28th April.


