

Second Rite of Penance. <u>How</u> to do that?? All those who wish to celebrate are asked to consider their sins, (spend some time reflecting on "<u>why</u> do I do these things") and write them and your answer down on a piece of paper BEFORE coming to church

that night (DO NOT include your name!!). The basic structure of the Second Rite is: Introduction, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of Penance and concluding rite. During the Liturgy of Penance, you will process forward, hand your **OPEN sheet** of paper to Father, receive Absolution and return to your place.




