Booking for Liturgies in general (e.g. normal weekend masses) – it is much PREFERABLE that, if you think you are going to be at a particular Mass, you book and then find you cannot attend — rather than not book and then turn up having to complete contact details and then be allocated seats (often with 1 minute to go before Mass starts!). 

ast weekend, I was reflecting with some people at church about why a number of families have not 'returned' since the start of the Pandemic - in many parishes including our own. There were three ideas offered as to why this may be the case (by someone who themselves needed to be away for several months):

1.**Health reasons** - their own, elderly parents or little children (e.g. catching the virus at church or elsewhere and passing it on to these people). - A *very valid and understandable reason*!!

My hopes - while "away" from our weekly gathering, are they nurturing their faith life properly? It's easy to miss Mass but not replace it with anything - the 'Mass or nothing' syndrome.

The Word of God and gathering with Community are essential for our Christian Faith - I really hope people (and families) are at least reading and reflecting on the Sunday Readings (a resource for adults and children is provided in every Friday email.) AND, I hope they remember to at least log on to our ZOOM (link in the newsletter and on our website - passcode is "eucharist" - without the inverted commas). In this, overcome the inclination to simply "watch" as they would every other TV show but be actively involved with responses, attitude etc as they would be in the church building.

2. Some people are **worried about taking up space** in the church and others missing out.

NO WORRIES!- we've NEVER had to turn people away (except Easter and Christmas because of special COVID rules) - we can always manage to find seats.

3. Some people **forget to book in** through Eventbrite. IF they're not sure how to do this, they are WELCOME to ring the parish office and Debra will guide them.

IF they FORGET or are TOO LATE TO BOOK - **TURN UP ANYWAY** - please *be early* - and you can complete contact tracing via a QR code or manually. It is helpful if they do book, but if they forget, no worries, **we WILL find a seat for them.**

We have adjusted to Coronavirus conditions in a safe way. In all likelihood, these conditions are going to persist for **at least the remainder of this year**. I am very concerned about how all our parishioners' (and their children's) faith is being nurtured with the long absence from Word, Community and Sacrament.
