Today (Sunday) we pray for Pu Reh, our Catechumen who is preparing for Baptism on Pentecost Sunday at the 9am Mass.

THE THINGS WE DO IN OUR PARISH (as well as all the things indivduals do to spread the "Good News" to work, family and society!

Ciborium Helpers

Assist with bringing out Ciborium from the tabernacle to the altar during Communion.

Computer/AV

Project the visual content onto the Church screens.

Computer/AV Trainee

An opportunity to learn how to operate the Computer AV at Mass. Volunteers needed.

Computer Streaming

Stream the Mass to the participants at home via Zoom.

Church Cleaning Helpers (COVID-19 GROUP)

Spray and wipe down the church seats & fixtures after Sunday mass. Takes about 20mins -- part of the Covid-19 regulations.

Marshall Helpers

From about 30 minutes before Mass, recording of those present – issue tickets, record those present whether pre-booked or not. (this will continue while the Covid regulations persist).

Altar Servers

Boys and Girls are eligible after celebrating Confirmation and First Holy Communion and are normally rostered at the Mass they usually attend. They will be trained "on the job". Adults are invited when there are no altar servers.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

Simplified Liturgy of the Word for Children helping them prepare to be more fully involved when with the adult community. Children dismissed after Gloria and return at Preparation of the Gifts. Leaders of CLOW, need to prepare and keep to the format of the Liturgy. Leader is accompanied by a 'helper'. This is offered during Sunday 9.00am Mass at times during the year.

Communion Ministers

For all people (16yrs and older) in our community with a regular commitment to celebrating Eucharist with us and have undertaken suitable training. They help share the One Bread and One Cup (the Body and Blood of Christ) with the community during the celebration of Mass.

Cordinators at Mass

Setting up for Mass is a great service to the community. Our Coordinators get to the church about 20 minutes before Mass. They set up the Chalices and Plates, Puri-

fiers and Corporals, Missals and Lectionaries. They light the candles, ensure there is an adequate supply of Bread and Wine and everything else that may be needed for this celebration. After Mass, they clean and return all to their proper place and, if necessary, lock up the church and Toilets. They are an invaluable resource working in the background.

Cantor

Music promotes participation of those gathered for Mass. This vital role of prayer in song comes to fruition in the liturgical celebration where the cantors lead the congregation in song. All cantors come together to sing on special occasions such as Christmas and Easter. The Musicians and Singers Group see themselves as a subcommittee of the Liturgy Group and work together with readers and audio-visual operators. This group meets regularly for practice, to learn new hymns and revise existing repertoire and to support new people to familiarize themselves with hymns/ Psalms etc. Band members meet monthly for practice and new members are always welcome. Faith Formation (overall)

The Parish Council is working on establishing two new areas of Faith Formation to accompany the current RCIA Team (see below) and Sacramental Team (see below).

Faith Formation ALPHA

One of these areas is the "ALPHA" programme which enables people through sharing a meal, watching a video, and developing a sense of belonging to come to know not just "about" Jesus but, more importantly "who" Jesus is. Faith Formation (Babies to PreSchool)

The other area the Council is planning for is to promote and provide resources to help parents form their babies and toddlers in the faith which they promised to do at Baptism. This will gradually progress over the years starting for 0-1 years up to 4 years in age. All of this is underpinned by the "Source and Summit" of our Christian life - regular celebration with their parent(s) at the weekend Mass.

Liturgy Group

Liturgy is the "Source and Summit" of our life as Christians. The Liturgy Group is a group of volunteers who form themselves in the documents on Liturgy in our church and then try to create an environment to enhance the worship of the community – especially around the Easter Ceremonies. Musicians and Singers Group

(addressing Social Isolation and Loneliness with a whole-of-person, whole-of-community and whole-of-government approach)
- 2. \$2B extra investment in transmission and storage over the next 2 years to achieve a just transition of our energy system. (This will deliver training an alternative jobs for our current Fossil Fuel Industry workers.)



a. Deliver funding for workplace rights education for vulnerable migrant workers e.g. Some of the women in our convent are being ripped off and treated terribly but don't know their rights at work.
