Teams

Teams are groups of four to seven couples that learn together to help each other bring Christ to their marriages and ultimately every phase of their lives. A team meets to share prayers, a simple meal, their life stories and events, their attempts (and often their failures) to grow together as a couple in union with God through discussion and sometimes sharing their material goods and skills.

Tri-Care Eucharistic Ministers

The team works in pairs (2 people) per visit. We offer to pray with and give the Holy Communion to the Catholic residents.

Welcoming

A "Welcome Pack" is available for new parishioners in the holders at the doorways of the church. It includes various information about our parish and invitations to become a part of our community via a census form, a request to share in responsibility for the maintenance of your new spiritual home though joining our Thanksgiving Programme; information about how we safeguard the welfare of children and vulnerable adults. (all these forms are also on our website.)

Should you wish your new home (if you've moved into our area) to be blessed, please see Fr Denis or contact the office to arrange a suitable time. If we can do anything else for you, please don't hesitate to ask.

Of course, we know that if you ask any of our current Parishioners, they will help you in any way they are able.

Youth Ministry

This is an age-specific religious ministry of faith group in the Parish usually from ages 12 to 30, whose mission is to support young people in the church as they move from their parents' and other authorities' understanding of faith to their own mature relationship with the Lord and His Body the Christian Community enacted in using their gifts for the good of the Community and the world..

Social Club

The Social Club is a Club: for people of any age, male and female, which meets in the parish hall on alternative Wednesdays to the Indoor Bowls Club. A cup of tea or coffee and a chat starts the morning. Fees: Annual Fee \$2.00, entry with a lucky door ticket \$1.00 and Raffle ticket \$1.00. Entertainment, Raffles, Bingo, Hoy, Bus Trips etc are provided. New Members are most welcome.

Tennis Court Hire

The parish owns two flexipave tennis courts, which are available for hire between 8.00am and 10.30pm seven days a week. We accept regular and casual bookings (depending on availability) and bookings can be made through the Parish Secretary.

Outside School Hours Care (Catholic Early EdCare - CEEP)

Previously a successful and profitable service run by the Parish. Since early 2000's has been managed by Centacare employed by the PARISH (not school) to provide Before and After School care for children and also Vacation Care. It's operation is overseen by the Parish Finance Council. It is supposed to support parents AND be a source of income for the parish.

Parish School - Queen of Apostles

The Queen of Apostles School is the major way in which we as a Parish Community try to fulfill the promise we made through the Godparent(s) at a child's baptism. The Parents of the child promised to bring he/she up in the "practice of the faith" and the Godparents promised to help the parent(s) in their duty as Christian Parents. The school has two campuses with children in Prep, Years one and two attending at the Early Years Campus at 46 Chuter Street and the children in Year Three to Year Six at the Thuruna Street Campus. Applications for enrolment can be submitted at the office at Thuruna Street. 
Our Lady Queen of Apostles Care for Creation Group

ational Reconciliation Week 27 May- 3 June 2021



This year marks twenty years of Reconciliation Australia. *More than a word. Reconciliaton takes action* urges all people to take up the challenge of brave and impactful action. The Reconciliation movement is 'at a

tipping point', with Black Lives Matter protests and increasing numbers of Australians taking part in Invasion Day rallies nationwide, people are understanding the truth and voicing their call for action on issues affecting Aboriginal people and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

More than a word. Reconciliation takes action calls on all Australians to take this awareness and knowledge and use it as a springboard to more substantive, brave and committed action.

The artwork commissioned by Reconciliation Australia was designed by Jessica Johnson. The artist explains..." The artwork reflects our connection and mutual obligation to one another, community and Country. Through commonality and difference, we



come together and achieve real change. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island peoples have been listening to the heart beat of the land and sea for generations. With their rainbow shaped souls the spirits ask for us to join and make reconciliation more than a word, take action. We need to

love one another and every aspect of the existing environment and community- we all have a role to play."

Elements of the Artwork

- Spirit souls= thinking/awareness
- The undulating landscape is shown through the contours at the base of the work
- Moons/planet= cycle and time
- Stars= navigation and knowing the way
- Boomerang= coming full circle. 20 boomerangs represent 20th anniversary of Reconciliation Australia
- Central river= the crying river represents the degradation/call for renewal.
