Brisbane parish awarded for environmental action BRISBANE's Our Lady, Queen of Apostles parish in Stafford has received three prestigious environmental awards recognising a commitment to climate and environmental action. The Five Leaf

Eco-Awards Basic Certificate, Eco
-Worship Award and Climate
Activism Award are an acknowledgement of many actions the
parish has taken through its Care
for Creation Group. These have
included setting up a contemplation garden, reduce, reuse and
recycle programs, environment
themed discussion groups and
liturgies, and letter writing for
climate action. The Stafford parish has also worked to support
other parishes in taking action.

Five Leaf Eco-Awards founder and director Jessica Morthorpe thanked Our Lady, Queen of



Apostles parishioners for their faithfulness to God's love for creation and for bringing Laudato Si' to life through their actions. Parish priest Fr Denis Scanlan said the Care for Creation Group was "a wonderful catalyst for our fellow parishioners". "With their expertise and energy, I and so many of our wonderful parishioners have been challenged and informed as to how we can more effectively undertake actions for the good of our planet," he said.



Heart of the Disciple is a new 28-day reflection resource for Advent or at any time during the 2022-2023 liturgical year. Its main purpose is to help us to find a few minutes each day to practice what it means to sit with God and to trust him to lead us forward.



Each day's reflection is inspired by a short text of scripture and concludes with a thought or two to take away and with a prayer.

Catholic Leadership Intensive Course News

Following the Leadership Intensive course the parishioners who attended have already met to plan how they might support and strengthen our parish. We wish to capitalise on this energy and enthusiasm. Our NCLS data shows that we are a highly relational parish but that connection with parish has declined by 50% since the onset of Covid. This project is aimed at reconnecting with those parishioners who have not returned to Sunday worship following Covid as well as reconnecting more broadly within the community. This project will reach out to existing parishioners to re-engage them with Church, initially with Christmas and Easter campaigns, followed by some locally provided opportunities for personal spiritual development.



Many families in Emdibir are subsistence farmers, and distressingly, many are unable to put enough food on the table each day.


