



Our ADVENT preparation for CHRISTMAS

Celebrating the Forgiveness of our Sins:

Why not celebrate our common Sinfulness and that God never ceases to forgive and show us mercy?

On **Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December, 6.00pm**, we will celebrate the Second Rite of Penance. **How to do that??** All those who wish to celebrate are asked to consider their sins, (spend some time reflecting on "why do I do these things") and write them and your answer down on a piece of paper BEFORE coming to church that night (DO NOT include your name!!). The basic structure of the Second Rite is: Introduction, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of Penance and concluding rite. During the Liturgy of Penance, you will process forward, hand your **OPEN sheet** of paper to Father, receive Absolution and return to your place.

"Simbang Gabi"



"Simbang Gabi" is a devotional, nine-day series of Masses attended by Filipino Catholics in anticipation of Christmas. It is the spiritual preparation for Christmas, in commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ. "Simbang Gabi" originated in the early days of Spanish rule over the Philippines as a practical compromise for farmers, who began work before sunrise to avoid the noonday heat out in the fields. Priests began to say Mass in the early mornings as early as 3.00 which would be followed by a simple breakfast shared amongst the famers.
