# Our ADVENT preparation for CHRISTMAS

Celebrating the Forgiveness of our Sins:
Why not celebrate our common Sinfulness and that God
never ceases to forgive and show us mercy?

On **Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December**, *6.30pm*, we will celebrate the Second Rite of Penance. **How to do that??** All those who wish to celebrate are asked to consider their sins, (spend some time reflecting on "why do I do these things") and write them and your answer down on a piece of paper BEFORE coming to church that night (DO NOT include your name!!). The basic structure of the Second Rite is: Introduction, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of Penance and concluding rite. During the Liturgy of Penance, you will process forward, hand your **OPEN sheet** of paper to Father, receive Absolution and return to your place.



# LENTEN PROGRAM


