Safeguarding update: March 2023

At its core, safeguarding is about promoting the safety and wellbeing of others, creating and maintaining safe activities and environments, and preventing abuse and harm.

Our Archdiocese has zero tolerance for all forms of abuse and is committed to safeguarding everyone involved in its activities, ministries, and services.

The safety and wellbeing of children and adults-at-risk is paramount. Our parish has a Local Safeguarding Representative whose role it is to ensure that the whole parish is aware of the importance of safeguarding children and vulnerable adults; promote safe practices including articulating for others what is appropriate and inappropriate behaviour; and assist the Parish Priest and staff in the implementation of the Archdiocesan Safeguarding Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy in the Parish. 

Things to consider:

There are more ministries required than usual (including Readers and other "unique" ministries for the Vigil.)

As usual "Churchbox" assumes you are AVAILABLE for your chosen ministries -- It is most important that if you are not available, you mark yourself as "Unavailable" in Churchbox --it'd be a tragedy if someone was rostered but did not turn up. The need to set yourself "Unavailable" is the usual procedure where you help us all by marking for yourself the Masses every weekend that you cannot serve. (If you are not sure how to set yourself "unavailable", please see instructions below).

There will be some ministries during the Easter Liturgies e.g. "Jug" we will have to **manually allocate**, so don't worry about them.

How do I record dates and times when I am not available?

From the 'Rotas' tab select the 'Your Availability' menu. You will see the dates and times of all the services and your availability. Click on 'Change' to update your availability.
