

10th June is an historic date for the First Australians, marking the savage murder of many people from an area just south of the Queensland/NSW border near Bingara. White settlers murdered 28 Aboriginal men, women and children near Myall Creek Station. The massacre is a harrowing reminder of Australia's colonial violence and one of the rare cases where killers were tried





"Your light must shine before all so that they may see goodness in your acts." (Matthew 5:16)

In the event that the parish has changed its name or been amalgamated with another parish or parishes, this gift shall be given to the parish which at the date of my death incorporates the major area of the Our Lady, Queen of Apostles - Stafford Parish as it exists at the time of making of this Will."

A personal response to the Referendum! Thirty years ago, during a 3 month sabbatical break, I lived with a community of sisters of another Order who supported Indige-

nous families, women and children on Palm Island in North Queensland. There I gained a glimmer of understanding of the impact of European settlement on Indigenous families. Now I feel concerned when people say that they will vote

No because they do not know enough about the referendum proposal. From my perspective, I think we know enough when we know that a Yes vote will require our Australian Constitution to acknowledge that the Indigenous Peoples of this Land officially exist and are entitled to be heard when decisions specifically affect them. The Parliament of Australia will continue to hold responsibility for making all decisions. I feel privileged to have this opportunity, and will vote YES in The Voice referendum!






ANDINTING OF THE SICK
