

VOICE REFERENDUM EXPLAINER

MHAT ARE O CHANGE?



If successful, these words will be added to our Constitution:

Chapter IX — Recognition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples

129 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice

In recognition of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as the First Peoples of Australia:

- (i) there shall be a **body**, to be called the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice;
- (ii) the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice may make representations to the Parliament and the Executive Government of the Commonwealth on matters relating to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples;
- (iii) the **Parliament** shall, subject to this Constitution, have power to make laws with respect to matters relating to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice, including its composition, functions, powers and procedures.

- For 122 years the Constitution has not acknowledged there were people here before European settlement. This addition provides that **recognition**, in the way requested by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in the Uluru Statement from the Heart.
- The body will consist of representatives of First Nations people across the country.
- The Voice has an **advisory** role only. It cannot make or block laws, manage programs or distribute funding – just advise government.
- **Executive** means Ministers and departments, who make and implement policies.
- This could include policies, programs and laws impacting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.
- The detail of how the Voice works will be determined by the Parliament so it can be adapted as needed.

We are moving closer to the referendum for a Voice to Parliament. You may have reached a decision about your vote, or you may still be considering how to vote. There are many different views and information conveyed in the media which can be confusing.

Our parish vision is "To Follow the Example of Jesus by Serving Others" encompassing Jesus's message of inclusion, love and compassion. How will we fulfil our vision and mission for this

important time in our history?



We are offering an opportunity for you to reflect on the message of Jesus and how that message informs our decision regarding the referendum. There are a series of discussions developed by the Brisbane

Archdiocese with a focus on the Uluru Statement from the Heart. Each includes short readings, quotes from the Uluru statement, a time for silent reflection and a discussion. Beginning on Monday 21 August, we are offering 4 weekly sessions each beginning at 7pm. Each discussion is about 1 hour and will be via the Parish Zoom link. An Eventbrite link will be available shortly for you to register your interest.

Let's join together to shape our response to this important question.

New Volunteer Safeguarding Accreditation Matrix

A new Standard titled "Volunteer Safeguarding Accreditation Requirements" has been approved and are now being implemented.



The Standard includes a revised Matrix (appendix) that sets out the volunteer requirements. The revised Matrix now only includes 28 of the most common/recognised

volunteer roles across parishes including those that have direct involvement with children and adults-at-risk. The Matrix does not include the very low risk mass participant roles for example, Readers, Extra-Ordinary Communion Ministers at Mass, and Welcomers at mass.

The online Volunteer Welcome Portal has been temporarily shut down to reconfigure it in line with the new volunteer accreditation

requirements. The Portal will be unavailable until such time as the reconfiguration is finalised and tested. In the interim parishes will

WHO GIVES A CRAP? Saving The World. One Wipe At A Time

Mr. Simon Griffiths, the Australian engineer and economist turned social entrepreneur talks about the 'a-ha moment' he had— to sell toilet paper and use the profits to build toilets and to call the venture Who Gives A Crap. He is the co-founder and CEO of the high-growth start-up Who Gives a Crap, a profit-forpurpose toilet paper company that uses 50% of its profits to build toilets in the developing world.
