CHRISTMAS on a MONDAY

Normally it is quite easy to determine what feast we celebrate on any given day. The higher-ranking feast take precedence over a lower-ranking commemoration. That gets quite tricky when Christmas falls on a Monday. Both the Fourth Sunday

of Advent and Christmas Day have the same ranking and both are what we call? days of obligation?. The question then arises: what do we celebrate on Sunday evening?

A common rule of thumb is that the actual day itself takes precedence over an anticipated Mass of the following day. But that will not work in this case. In Australia, people's certain expectation will be that Christmas Eve will feature celebrations of the Christmas solemnity, and not the Advent Sunday.

Therefore, while it is technically possible to celebrate the Advent Sunday with an evening Mass on Sunday 24 December, it would not be wise to do so. They should be the usual Christmas Masses which people have come to expect. The Sunday will therefore be celebrated on the evening of Saturday 23 and the morning of Sunday 24. **by Tom Elich, Liturgy Brisbane**

We often sing a hymn "Faith in the Future" (The one that starts with "Whoa, Whoa...". Some people have asked why "Two Hundred reasons to sing..." is included. The hymn was composed to celebrate 200 years of Catholic Education in Australia is the reason. However because of confusion and the misunderstanding that it refers to European Colonisation in Australia, I've written to the composer (Fr Rob Galea) and to the National Catholic Education Commission (who own the rights) and asked if he can change the words to be more appropriate for a Parish Setting.

I am really happy that people noticed the "200 years" and were concerned about its implication. - Denis

Our ADVENT preparation for **CHRISTMAS**

Celebrating the Forgiveness of our Sins: Why not celebrate our common Sinfulness and that God

never ceases to forgive and show us mercy?

On Thursday 14th (NOT 12th) December, 6.30pm, we will celebrate the Second Rite of Penance. How to do that?? All those who wish to celebrate are asked to consider their sins, (spend some time reflecting on "why do I do these things") and write them and your answer down on a piece of paper BEFORE coming to church that night (DO NOT include your name!!). The basic structure of the Second Rite is: Introduction, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of Penance and concluding rite. During the Liturgy of Penance, you will process forward, hand your OPEN sheet of paper to Father, receive Absolution and return to vour place.
